**Scholarships for Champions**

**Reserved Football Parking Policies**

By approval of the Board of Directors, the following policies are now in effect for the 2008 TCU Football season:

**1. Pricing**

- a. Young Alumni Reserved Parking is available only to TCU Alumni whose date of their Bachelor's degree is after May 1999.
- b. Young Alumni Parking spaces are limited one space per graduate.
- c. Young Alumni Parking spaces are available in limited quantity.

## **2. Enrollment & Payment Policy**

- a. All persons requesting donor parking passes ***must be TCU Football season ticket holders***. Minimum one season ticket.
- b. All parking gifts are due in full, in advance of the football season in which donors wish to park. All donor parking renewals are due by May 1 each year. Parking passes will be distributed to the donor once the required gift is received by TCU in full.
- c. Pledges may not be applied to football parking and pledges are not considered payment.
- d. **One Principal Donor per parking spot.** Groups sharing a spot should designate one person to be the account holder for the parking spot. **No split payments please.**

Note: TCU Faculty/Staff who pay via Payroll Deduction must notify the TCU Frog Club Office of their intentions regarding their parking gift by the May 1 deadline and must adjust their payroll deduction in accordance to the gift level required by the desired lot location.

NO PARKING PASSES WILL BE DISTRIBUTED TO DONORS UNTIL THEIR GIFT HAS CLEARED PROCESSING THROUGH TCU DEVELOPMENT INFORMATION SYSTEMS TO INSURE CLEARANCE OF CREDIT CARD AND CHECK PAYMENTS.

e. Additional Charges

### **FORMS OF PAYMENT**

- By Check - The TCU Frog Club accepts personal checks made payable to TCU FROG CLUB
- Online Payment  
Donors may pay for parking online at the TCU Frog Club website, [www.TCUfrogclub.com](http://www.TCUfrogclub.com) with a credit card or checking account transfer. Credit card payments made be made using MasterCard, VISA, American Express or Discover Card.

### **RENEWAL PERIOD**

The renewal period for football parking for current donors is February 1 – May 1 each year. All renewals must be in by May 1 to reserve a previously held parking space.

### **3. Administrative Policies**

a. Wait List

Donors wishing to be placed on a wait list for a parking lot requiring an increase in gift level may gain access to the wait list on a first come, first-served basis. The gift level for all wait lists is \$500 per year per name in addition to the donor's current parking gift.

b. DISTRIBUTION OF PARKING PASSES

Parking Passes will be available for **pick-up** at the Frog Club Office **beginning June 15**. Those passes not picked up will be sent to the donor via express mail with delivery confirmation no later than 10 days prior to the date of the first home game.

### **4. Usage of Parking Space**

Donor parking spaces are intended for the private use of the donor and guests. No Commercial use of the parking spots is allowed. No commercial or promotional giveaways may be executed in donor lots or by those holding donor parking passes.

## **Parking Lot Rules**

### **RESERVED DONOR PARKING**

ALL PARKING LOTS ADJACENT TO AMON CARTER STADIUM ARE AVAILABLE ON A SEASON-BASIS ONLY! SPACE IS LIMITED.

### **GENERAL DONOR PARKING**

General Parking is available on a season basis in Lots 4, 8, 13 and 14.

**No Tents or shelters are allowed on the parking surface in General Parking lots.**

One pass entitles the holder to one parking space slot. Please tailgate behind your vehicle and keep tailgating items adjacent to front or rear of your vehicle. Tailgating or gathering is not permitted in fire lanes or in the road way.

## **PUBLIC PARKING**

**Public Parking is available on a limited basis in Lot 13, between the TCU Baseball Stadium and the TCU Soccer Stadium for \$10 per game.**

**FREE Parking is available on east side of the TCU campus.**

**FREE Parking at Paschal High School with continuous Shuttle Service to and from the stadium throughout the game.**

## **REGULATIONS**

- No kegs will be allowed in parking lots. Personal containers only. Please, no glass containers.
- No alcohol allowed in Lot 5.
- The drinking age in Texas is 21. Please observe all local and state laws.
- Fire extinguishers (ABC) or a bucket of water must accompany any BBQ or pit. Dump stations are available in Lots 1 and 3 for coals and or ashes.
- Please place all trash into trash receptacles and help keep our stadium clean.
- One pass, one parking space slot. Please tailgate behind your vehicle and keep tailgating items adjacent to front or rear of your vehicle. Tailgating or gathering is not permitted in fire lanes or in the road way.
- No food, drink, large bags, umbrellas, external noise makers or weapons are allowed inside the stadium gates.
- Donor parking spaces are intended for the private use of the donor and guests. No Commercial use of the parking spots is allowed. No commercial or promotional giveaways may be executed in donor lots or by those holding donor parking passes.

- NOTE: Violations will be cited by TCU PD or FWPD. TABC rules govern all alcohol usage.
